Dear Families, Happy New Year to you all. I hope that you all had a lovely Christmas and enjoyed spending time with families during the break.

OFSTED - Hopefully, you all received the Parentmail which contained the official report from our Ofsted visit in November. Your children were fantastic during the visit and you should be proud of them all. The staff are proud of the outcomes of the report and there were many positives highlighted during the visit. Thank you to all the parents who spoke to inspectors and said such nice things about our school.

Cold weather conditions - Please ensure your child has suitable warm clothing, hats, gloves etc during this cold spell of weather. We are still going outside for break and lunchtimes so the children need suitable clothing and footwear.

Bikeability - Sessions for Year 5 children start this Monday 13<sup>th</sup> January. There are still a few spaces left, but you will need to pick up a form tonight after school or Monday morning if you wish your child to secure a place. Can all children taking part please remember to bring their helmet alongside their bike on Monday.

## Reminders

Earrings – should not be worn in school and either be removed by the child or taped up to enable them to take part in PE etc.

PE Kit - All children should be wearing our Glynwood PE T-shirts or sports hoodies for PE days - No-one should be wearing football tops.

School Day - The school day starts at 8.45am and finishes at 3.15pm. Some parents arrive at almost 9.00am every day and this means the gates are not being locked on time and also means your child is missing vital reading time or daily routines in class. Please make sure your child arrives on time and comes into school through their designated entry point. The school office staff are always busy and often struggle to get late arrivals to their classes when they come through the main entrance. Children should only be collected early from school by prior arrangement with the Head Teacher or for the occasional appointment - it should not be happening regularly.

Afterschool club/ breakfast club - Did you know that you can get help towards the costs. We are registered with the Government Tax-free childcare initiative. Money Owing - Please can you check your balances in Parentmail for school meals, breakfast club and afterschool club.

Reporting absences – if your child is going to be absent from school, it is essential that you let school know either through the ParentMail app or by phoning the school office. If we do not receive a reason for absence then we may conduct an unannounced home visit to ensure the welfare of the whole family.

## Child Protection and Safeguarding

Child Protection and Safeguarding are always an absolute priority in school.
