Dear Families,

The children engaged well with Safer Internet Day this week; lots of them have shown a great understanding of how to stay safe online. We will continue to keep Online Safety a priority at school through regular Computing lessons, assemblies and awareness sessions. In school we have excellent monitoring and filtering systems to ensure that the children do keep safe online, but of course the same software is not available at home. We do urge you to carefully consider the access your child has to the internet. Resources sent out this week should support this. We will also be organising an in-school online safety workshop that we will be encouraging as many people as possible to attend.

WhatsApp - In a similar vein to the message above, a WhatsApp group called 'Everybody add Everybody' is currently circulating. We have received information sharing that this group holds explicit images. If your child does have WhatsApp, we would suggest that you speak to your child about this group and check their phones to make sure that they are not a member.

**Up to date Contact information** - Please ensure that we have the most up to date contact information for parents and carers. If you are leaving a work number, please try and give the most direct number possible: this will allow us to contact you quickly in an emergency.

Crossing patrol at Southend Road - Unfortunately, there is still no replacement crossing patrol person in post, so please help your child to cross the road safely until one is appointed. I am aware that this is far from an ideal situation; it is currently in the hands of the local authority, but we will continue to pass on our concerns.
