Dear Families,

There have been some exciting events this week. I know that for our Reception and some of our Year 5 children, the Dance Festival was a fantastic experience. I am sure that this will be a fantastic memory for the children who took part.

Many thanks for those of you who have attended the parent/ carer consultations for Reception and KS2 this week. We are lucky to have such a supportive group of parents here at Glynwood. KS1 consultations will take place on Wednesday 2nd April – you should have received appointments, but please see your child's class teacher if you haven't.

We have noticed a number of Y5 and Y6 children are bringing in **bank cards and money** to school. We are concerned about children losing these and we cannot take responsibility for any money or bank cards brought into school. Please encourage your children to leave these at home.

There were unforeseen circumstances on Thursday morning this week and the school gates and breakfast club doors were not open quite as early as usual. Please note that **breakfast club** does not begin until 7:30am and the doors should not be open before this time. Staff are in school preparing for the session prior to this, but they are not responsible for children until 7:30am. I would also like to stress that at times there are some circumstances that are beyond our control and it is essential that families treat staff with respect and courtesy. Verbal aggression is not acceptable under any circumstances.

Faith Day will be held on the last day of term <mark>– Friday 11th April</mark>. Families are invited into school from 3:45pm to look at some of the children's work and see what they have learned in RE this term.

Sporting Success – Apart from the fantastic performances at the Dance Festival, the school football team continues to go from strength to strength with a convincing 3 – 1 victory against Larkspur this week. There is one more fixture to complete and then it will be the girls turn for their football league to begin. Lunchtime football practices will start on Monday for the girls in year 5 and 6, so please remind your child to bring their kit, boots and shin pads if interested.
