Packed lunches – As Kinder Bueno bars do contain nuts; please do not send them into school.


Vaping is strictly forbidden on site - there have been reports of family members vaping on the school grounds during Sports Days and at other outdoor events, please leave the school grounds if you wish to vape.

**Pick up and drop off** – please stay away/ don't allow children to play on the rails/ ramps outside of the 5/6 classrooms – a child was nearly hurt when a member of staff opened a door onto a small child on the ramp

Reminder that children should not be playing on the play equipment in the playgrounds at pick up and drop off time - we have noticed that this play is often unsupervised and therefore unsafe.

Lining up on the terrace - (Reception) - doors open at 8.45 and close at 8.55 for lessons to start, please don't arrive too early as we understand that standing in a line for any length of time, especially for our younger children, can be difficult. This can cause conflict and tension for the children and their families before the children have entered school.
