## Message from Mrs. Nellis:

Author visits – Years 4,5 and 6 had a virtual author visit from Maz Evans on Wednesday. The children have given some excellent feedback from the session.



Years One, Two and Three will be having a local author visit from Tracey Horner on the 11<sup>th</sup> October. Tracey will be holding an assembly and workshop in school and she also happens to be an ex-pupil of Glynwood - we are excited to welcome her back!

**PE Kit-** please ensure that children are wearing a PE kit for school on their PE days, including trainers.

**Earrings-** Earrings should not be worn for school. If they cannot be safely removed, then they must be covered with plasters or tape. This is Gateshead LA policy.

Spare Wellies – Mrs Allom and Mr Allom would be very grateful for any spare wellies for Forest School sessions.

Healthy snack – Children in Years 3-6 may bring a healthy snack for playtime (younger children have free fruit supplied). Please ensure that these snacks are nut free (including nut free chocolate spread).

**48 hours after vomiting** and diarrhoea – following NHS and Gateshead health and safety guidance, children can only return to school after they have had no sickness or diarrhoea incidents for 48 hours. A recent bug has affected both pupils and staff, so it is essential that we follow the rules.

Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> October is **Hello Yellow Day** and as usual we will be marking this day by wearing something yellow. This does not need to be an all yellow outfit - a pair of socks, a hair bobble or a pattern including yellow would all be great! There is no donation needed - this is a mental health awareness day.

**Food Bank collection** - We will be collecting for Gateshead Food Bank as we have done on previous years this collection will be between 16<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> October and more information will be sent out next week.

**Parking** – another reminder about parking courteously.
