#### Message from Mrs. Nellis:

It has been another great week in school. The children continue to settle into their new classes and routines. Children in Years 1-6 should all have **reading books/ home readers now**. Children in Reception will be receiving reading books soon. For those of you who would like more information about phonics and how to help your child's reading at home, then please do attend the **phonics and reading workshop that Mrs.** Commons will be delivering on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> November.

We would be grateful if parents and carers could refrain from vaping on the school grounds, including the area outside the main office entrance.

We have had a number of complaints again about **parking**, particularly around the main Glynwood Gardens gate. It is NOT safe to block these gates in any way. Many members of our school community have commented on the danger to children of unsafe parking (and maneuvers) and emergency vehicles must be able to access the school and the surrounding streets at all times. Please be considerate when parking. <u>Also remember that you can park in the Beacon Lough Baptist</u> Church car park and use the Southend Road entrance.

#### Child Protection and Safeguarding

Child Protection and Safeguarding are always an absolute priority in school. Our designated safeguarding leads and deputies are: Vicky Nellis (Head Teacher), Carolyn Dobbing (Home School Liaison Officer), Simon Otterson (Deputy Head), Esther Commons (SENDco) and Jude Etherington (Curriculum leader). Please talk to any of us about any concerns that you may have. Posters displaying photos of the designated safeguarding leads are displayed around school.

If you have concerns about a child in your community, you have a number of options:

- 1) You can call 101 and ask for some welfare advice. This can be done anonymously.

**Online safety** is a safeguarding focus for all schools this year. Online safety assemblies have been held this week for children in Years 1-6. Talking to your child about the best way of keeping safe online would be a useful way of checking their understanding of this very important matter.
