Message from Mrs. Nellis:

<u>We are delighted to welcome the children back after the summer break.</u> The children have settled so well into their new year groups and I am very proud of their excellent attitudes to learning so early in the term and after a long holiday too! The new starters in Reception and Nursery are really impressing the staff with their personalities and independence.

<u>Dates</u> - Please see above for dates for your diaries - these dates will be updated each week, so please do check regularly for new additions to the lists.

<u>PE Kits and days</u> - Children can continue to wear their PE kits on PE days. Class teachers will be letting you know PE days for each class. Earrings should not be worn in school. If children cannot remove their earrings then please ensure that they are taped up each day.

<u>Health and Safety</u> (bikes, parking etc) Please ensure that children are not riding their bikes or scooters on the school premises. They should dismount at the school gates.

Please remember to park safely around the school site. It is essential that emergency vehicles can get up and down streets without obstruction.

Child Protection and Safeguarding

Child Protection and Safeguarding are always an absolute priority in school. Our designated safeguarding leads and deputies are: Vicky Nellis (Head Teacher), Carolyn Dobbing (Home School Liaison Officer), Simon Otterson (Deputy Head), Esther Commons (SENDco) and Jude Etherington (Curriculum leader). Please talk to any of us about any concerns that you may have. Posters displaying photos of the designated safeguarding leads are displayed around school.

If you have concerns about a child in your community, you have a number of options:

- 1) You can call 101 and ask for some welfare advice. This can be done anonymously.

<u>Reading Books</u> -If you have any school reading books at home from the end of last term, please return them to school as soon as possible.

We are continuing to develop the range of books in school, if you have any unwanted reading books at home then we would be very grateful for any donations that you might be able to offer.

School Meals - Did you know you can book your child's school meal in at home?

It would be really useful if you could book your child's school meal on the Parentmail app. Log in and go to the accounts section. Meals can be booked up to one day before use.

School Clubs - we have again engaged the service of Active Kids and Dance Fuse to provide some afterschool clubs this year. Unfortunately, due to costs we have had had to restrict this to 3 evenings per week - when your child's year group have a club you will receive a parentmail asking if you would like to sign your child up. Numbers are restricted, so please check with your child that they want to attend the club and that they are happy to commit to all sessions. This will ensure that we are not turning children down unnecessarily.

We will again be welcoming the Chimney Sweep Theatre Company in on Wednesday lunchtimes to provide a club for children in Years 1 - 6, if you are interested please click on the appropriate link below to register.
