Dear Families, I hope that this newsletter finds you well and you have had a pleasant week.

We had an unplanned fire drill at lunchtime today as one the alarms was accidentally activated. The children were incredibly sensible and followed our fire alarm routines very well. I'm sure that they will tell you all about it!

Parking and child safety – A few parents have been reporting near misses at pick up and drop off time with cars and children around the busy areas of Coniston Gardens and Glynwood Gardens. Please take extra care with parking and try to avoid parking on the pavements and bend at the junction of Southend Road and Coniston Gardens. Can parents make sure children access their cars from the pavement side if at all possible as some children have been walking into the road into oncoming traffic.

School Start time - Children are expected to be on site to start the day at 8:45 am. There are still a number of families regularly coming to school between 8:55 and 9:00 am and consequently your child is missing essential reading/work/playtime as a result. Gates are supposed to be locked at 8:55, so we would appreciate if children can be dropped off in time so that all parents/carers can be off site by 8:55 am.

Uniform – Please can you make sure your children's coats, jumpers, hoodies etc. have their name in. Staff are spending a lot of time looking for lost property each week that would be easily identifiable if names were put onto labels.
