Dear Families, I hope that this newsletter finds you well.

It has been a very busy week with lots going on! As you will be aware we had our OFSTED inspection on Tuesday and Wednesday. It was an incredibly thorough process that involved 5 inspectors over the two days. A report will be published in the next couple of months and a link to this will be sent to parents. I would like to take this opportunity to say thank you to those parents who completed the online questionnaire and those who spoke to the inspectors on the school yard over the two days. The children were central to the inspection process and lots of them spoke directly to the inspectors - they were wonderful, as they always are. A huge thank you to the staff who worked incredibly hard to showcase our school as well as welcoming the inspectors into lessons and attending multiple meetings with them.

Christmas Cards/Gifts orders with Class Fundraising – a second on-line shop is being opened from 15th – 25th November for anyone who missed placing an initial order.

Robinwood - The children had a fabulous time at Robinwood and thoroughly enjoyed their visit. The whole year group were incredibly well behaved and represented our school fantastically well. Parents evening – For parents of children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2, you now have a new date of Wednesday 27th November. Staff in Reception classes said parents can keep their original appointment times for this new date if convenient – if you need a new time, please contact a member of staff.

Pick up times - When arranging for someone else to pick up your child at hometime, please make contact with your child's class teacher in advance to let them know the details, or ring the office to give your permission for your child to go with a different trusted adult. Thank you.

Indoor Athletics – Children represented the school in the Gateshead finals yesterday and performed extremely well coming 9^{th} out of 75 schools who entered.

Children in Need day – Thank you for all your donations, so far we have raised £369.58. The children looked fantastic in their clothing and face paints.

Request for help - Staff in Reception would still like your help please for their outdoor area in school. Donations of watering cans, buckets, guttering, plants, wheelbarrows, large stones, conkers and tarpaulin would be most useful. Thank you in advance.

Playground equipment - Could parents waiting for children at the end of the day please remind the children that they should not be using the equipment from boxes in the yard after the equipment has been tidied away at lunchtime.

Reading folders – Could parents in KS2 please make sure your child has their reading book and reading record with them every day. Please try to read with your child as much as you can at home.

Earrings - a polite reminder that children should have their earrings taped up if they are unable to remove them for school.

Uniform - A polite reminder that uniform should have names in labels please to avoid the wrong pieces of uniform coming home with children by mistake.

Reporting absences – if your child is going to be absent from school, it is essential that you let school know either through the ParentMail app or by phoning the school office. If we do not receive a reason for absence then we may conduct an unannounced home visit to ensure the welfare of the whole family.

Child Protection and Safeguarding

Child Protection and Safeguarding are always an absolute priority in school.
