Dear Families, I hope that this newsletter finds you well.

After School Club please find attached a copy of our After School Club Policy, can I draw your attention to the section that deals with late pick ups. We have noticed that the number of late pick ups have increased recently and would like to remind you that if you are late collecting your child, you will incur an additional charge.

Afterschool club/ breakfast club - Did you know that you can get help towards the costs. We are registered with the Government Tax-free childcare initiative, please see the attached flyer and click on the link. https://www.gov.uk/tax-free-childcare our school post code is NE9 5SY.

Drop off times - Please can we try to drop off children at 8:45 am as there are still a number of families who are regularly arriving at 8:55 or later - this means your child is missing ten or 15 minutes of learning time on a regular basis and it is making it difficult to close our gates on time and secure the school promptly.

School dinners - Can parents of children in KS1 please discuss their lunch choices before school as many children are not sticking to the choices made on Parentmail meaning the older children sometimes do not get the choices they have ordered.

Parents' evening – Thank you to all of the parents and carers for attending the parents' evenings across the past couple of weeks. They were really positive and beneficial for staff and we hope you found them useful.

Playground equipment - Could parents waiting for children at the beginning and end of the day please remind the children that they should not be using the equipment from boxes in the KS2 yard.

Reading folders – Could parents please make sure your child has their reading book and reading record with them every day. Please try to read with your child as much as you can at home.

Earrings - a polite reminder that children should have their earrings taped up if they are unable to remove them for school.

Cold weather clothing – can we ask that pupils wear a warm coat for school and have hats and gloves if possible as some children are attending school only in their school jumpers. Remember to pop your child's name on any items they bring to school if you can to help avoid them getting lost.

Christmas Dinner - If your child would like a Christmas dinner on Thursday 12th December please can you book it in on Parentmail as soon as possible. Please note we will only be serving a turkey dinner or a vegetarian dinner on this day. Please provide your child with a packed lunch if they do not want a Christmas dinner.

Reporting absences – if your child is going to be absent from school, it is essential that you let school know either through the ParentMail app or by phoning the school office. If we do not receive a reason for absence then we may conduct an unannounced home visit to ensure the welfare of the whole family.

Child Protection and Safeguarding

Child Protection and Safeguarding are always an absolute priority in school.
